Options for leaving a gift in your Will.



After providing for your loved ones, leaving a gift to a cause you care deeply about will help people at the most vulnerable time of their lives. Options available include:

A Specific Bequest

This is a sum of money, property, shares or any other items of value that you nominate.

Suggested wording:

I give [nominated sum/item] to Busselton Hospice Care Inc, trading as Busselton Hospice Care Inc. of PO Box 5103, Busselton West, WA, 6280 (ABN 34 520 860 920) for its general purposes, free of all duties and encumbrances and declare that the receipt of an authorized officer at the time being, shall be sufficient discharge of my executor's duty.

A Percentage Bequest

This is a percentage value of your entire estate without identifying specific items of value.

Suggested wording:

I give [nominated %] of my estate to Busselton Hospice Care Inc, trading as Busselton Hospice Care Inc. of PO Box 5103, Busselton West, WA, 6280 (ABN 34 520 860 920) for its general purposes, free of all duties and encumbrances and declare that the receipt of an authorized officer at the time being, shall be sufficient discharge of my executor's duty.

A Residual Bequest

This is what is left in your estate after money and other items have been distributed according to your wishes.

Suggested wording:

I give the rest and residue of my estate, both real and personal to Busselton Hospice Care Inc, trading as Busselton Hospice Care Inc. of PO Box 5103, Busselton West, WA, 6280 (ABN 34 520 860 920) for its general purposes, free of all duties and encumbrances and declare that the receipt of an authorized officer at the time being, shall be sufficient discharge of my executor's duty.

Of course, you should seek legal advice about the best way for you to express your intentions in your Will.
